## Empire Period Creusot Crystal And Mahogany Liqueur Cellar - Complete With Glasses

### Description

Beautiful early 19th century liqueur or whisky cellar. It includes 6 bottles and 12 goblets in Le Creusot crystal, housed in a luxurious mahogany veneered case with mahogany veneer with brass corners, retractable lyre handles and a blank monogrammed plate. The interior is sheathed in gilded red moroccogilding. Each decanter has its own and numbered in the box, making it possible to draw up a list of the spirits presented like several whiskies or Cognacs, while still being able to identify each even in the absence of a label. Our cellar has kept its rare set of 12 liqueur tumblers on the red morocco-covered stand, an accessory that has generally disappeared. It is therefore extremely complete, including its working key. This is a late Empire or early Restoration work, circa 1820. The

original glassware is molded and cut crystal. The set is in excellent condition. Carafes and goblets intact, a few small chips at the ends of the stoppers.
