### Description

Entirely crafted from solid marble, it features a harmonious architectural composition, with a circular top supported by a subtly molded capital, a slender cylindrical shaft articulated with delicate ring turnings, and a stepped octagonal base that provides both stability and visual balance. The marble is particularly striking, displaying a richly variegated pattern in tones of white, grey, and charcoal, with natural veining that creates a soft, cloud-like effect across the surface.
