Description

50s modernist cabinet with light wood compass legs and openwork panels French 1950s-1960s dressing cabinet in light wood, with a design typical of post-war modernism. The front is punctuated by large geometrically decorated openwork panels, framed by uprights adorned with highly graphic undulating clerestories, which bring a real visual singularity to the ensemble. The whole piece rests on an elegant compass base, light and dynamic, characteristic of the period. The interior is particularly functional, designed as a real dressing room: closet on the left, shelves and compartments on the right, with low drawers for structured storage. The design testifies to utilitarian yet meticulous furniture, where aesthetics and use meet perfectly. Furniture review: this type of piece

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perfectly embodies the spirit of the 50s, between rationality and decorative research. The contrast between the rigor of the structure and the whimsy of the wavy claustras creates an interesting balance. The piece remains very legible, visually light despite its volume, and offers strong decorative potential in a contemporary or vintage interior. Good overall condition. A few traces of normal use, light marks on the inner bottom and minor wear and tear on the edges and base. Sound overall, solid structure.
