Description

Hermès silk scarf, "Plumes" model, designed by Henri de Linares. First issued in 1953 and reissued in 1964 and 1999, this emblematic design occupies a significant place in the decorative arts history of the Maison Hermès. It pays tribute to the traditional craft of the plumassiers, whose feather work once adorned equestrian finery and ceremonial costumes. This hand-rolled silk Carré 90 (approx. 35 × 35 in), with its soft light-pink border, is presented in very good overall condition: supple and luminous silk, well-preserved hand-rolled edges, and fresh colors. A lightly pulled thread and a few minute traces are noted, without affecting the harmony of the piece. Professional packaging. Fast, tracked shipping within France and internationally.
