Description

This Chinese porcelain vase, decorated in the Famille Rose style, features a delicate scene of birds perched on flowering branches, rendered with bright colors and careful pictorial work typical of late Qing dynasty production. The whole is framed by a rich blue and gold ornamental decoration, punctuated by floral motifs and geometric borders that underline the elegance of the form and the finesse of the enamel. This vase is also characterized by its flared neck, belly and slightly narrowed foot. It bears the "Qiánlóng" stamp in homage to imperial models from the XVIIIe century, a common practice in workshops active around 1900. The object stands out for its decorative balance, vivid palette and decorative charm, making it an ideal piece for a collection or to bring a touch of
