Description

Art Deco cameo glass vase signed Le Verre Français, "Palmettes" pattern, circa 1927-1928. Elegant trumpet-shaped vase in multilayer glass: a mottled pink opalescent ground overlaid with a purple layer flecked with cobalt blue inclusions, acid-etched with a design of stylised palmettes rising in a fan from the base. The slender silhouette, flaring toward the neck, rests on a wide circular foot in purple glass densely speckled with blue, which reinforces the graphic rhythm of the motif, characteristic of Schneider's late 1920s production at Épinay-sur-Seine. The surface displays a matte satin finish obtained by acid-etching, creating a refined contrast between the frosted ground and the brighter décor, a hallmark of Le Verre Français vases.
