Description

JEAN-JACQUES ARGUEYROLLES (BORN IN 1954) A self-taught artist, he has cultivated absolute freedom of spirit. Whether in his striking sculptures or his superb furniture designs, he is recognized as a "Sculptor-Designer" with an international reputation. This dining table has a strong sculptural presence, composed of a rectangular top made of oxidized metal sheet patinated with gold leaf. The surface features a rhythmic decoration of arrow-shaped cutouts, enlivened in its center by an abstract motif, giving the whole an almost totemic dimension. The wrought iron base is distinguished by its inclined lines and double uprights framing geometric patterns. Each leg rests on arrowhead finials, reinforcing the assertive and singular character of the piece. The entire structure is reinforced by
