Belgian painter and draughtsman. Trained at the Saint-Gilles Academy and with Frans Gaillard. with Frans Gaillard. Painter of old places and little streets of Brussels canal views, landscapes, forest views of the Rouge-Cloître area Rouge-Cloître surroundings, portraits. Powerful, spontaneous strokes, subdued palette. Friend of Désiré Haine. Alain Viray called him the "Utrillo of Brussels". In 1965, the commune of Auderghem awarded him the G.E. Lebon prize. He won the gold medal at the overall exhibition in Paris, the gold medal medal at Villers-la-Ville, and in 1972, the Baron Steens
