A small pirogue glides languidly along, propelled by the boatman's oar, its movement barely disturbing the liquid calm of this bucolic, impressionistic landscape. In the distance, a small house stands out among the trees lining the opposite bank, evoking the tranquility of a forgotten refuge where worries seem to fade away on the horizon.
