Description

The Children of Bacchus - Flemish school, 18th century
Couple of grape-pickers holding a basket of grapes
Beautiful oil on canvas marouflaged on panel depicting a pair of grape-pickers in the tradition of the Flemish school. The man, dressed in a loose-fitting white shirt and green bonnet, is holding an abundant basket of white grapes adorned with vine leaves. Beside him is a woman wearing a wide-brimmed straw hat adorned with a rose, wearing a white puffed collar and dark dress, poses naturally. The composition, the treatment of skin tones and the Bacchic iconography directly evoke Flemish genre scenes, in the tradition of Jordaens and his followers. The dark background contrasting with the light of the figures reinforces this stylistic connection.
