Large gilt bronze and marble portico clock, monumental model with double columns in black and white marble, adorned with a very rich trim of chased and mercury gilded bronzes in matt and glossy with scrolling motifs, acanthus leaves, garlands of fruit. At the top, an eagle with outstretched wings. Enamel dial signed Dubois Fils, rue Saint Honoré 20, Paris, and chased gilt bronze hands. Late Louis XVI period, just before the Revolution. A large, highly decorative piece, our clock is in very good condition. Gilding perfectly preserved and cleaned piece by piece. Wire movement (our watchmaker is currently carrying out a complete overhaul). Height: 52cm Width : 36,3cm Depth : 10cm
