Pretty and precious reliquary dated 1862 of the 'rocks of holy places and Sepulchres', with colored paperrolles and glassware. (Napoleon III period) In its blackened wooden frame with protective glass on the front. Contains four precious rocks of holy places with handwritten paperrolles: Maison de la Ste Vierge à Jérusalem Sépulcre de Notre Seigneur Pierre du Sépulcre de Ste Ceresse Pierre de la flagellation de N.S. On the back, the handwritten history of this reliquary annotated in pen: "These relics were given to Sr. Marie des Anges Vallois by Sr. Marie Euphrasie de Marie Superior of Our Good Shepherd Monastery in Cairo, who brought them back from Jerusalem, where she went in April 1862."
