Model of 1er Vendémiaire An XII (24 Septembre 1803), signed "Boutet Directeur Artiste - Manufacture à Versailles" with converted percussion flintlock. Smooth five-sided barrel, burnished and gilded thunderbolt decoration mounted on wood by two drawer pins, fixed thunderbolt frog, muzzle point. Left side panel signed "Boutet Directeur Artiste"; top panel stamped Nicolas Boutet on gold background "NB", right side panels signed "Manufacture à Versailles" and flat-bodied percussion hammer. Long walnut shaft. Cut-out iron fittings, chased screw heads. Two die-cut and chased counterplates. Two molded rod holders. Sloping, finely chequered stock, oval pommel. Oval-shaped silver cap with high rim, cast in relief and chased, depicting a Jupiter head
