China, Late Qing or Minguo, circa 1900-1920, delightful porcelain baluster vase, the wide, flared neck ending in a cup shape. The decorations are in coral-red (or iron-red) enamels composed of blossoming lotuses, leaves and foliage on the body- as well as the neck - constrained between two friezes of lotus petals enhanced by floral ornaments. The base of the neck is surrounded by a frieze of ruyi, while the top features a register of archaic geometric forms. The moving handles depict stylized Fo lions. The pierced base bears an apocryphal six-character zuangshu mark of the emperor Qianlong (1736-1795). This type of decoration is a continuation of the "blue whites" of the Ming and Qing eras, itself inspired by floral interlacing from the Middle East. The lotus represents union and
