Flamed earthenware Art Deco vase with salamander decoration - Saint-Clément, circa 1930
Elegant Art Deco earthenware vase with a deep brown flamed glaze shaded with black and ochre, featuring a beautiful speckled and slightly glittery effect throughout. The body is adorned with a relief decoration featuring a stylized salamander, applied to the surface and treated in a spirit typical of French decorative productions of the years 1925-1935. Very fine quality of glaze, with drips and firing variations giving the piece great visual richness. The base is fully enameled, with a support ring left unfinished, characteristic of production in eastern France. An incised monogram below the base is visible (GC), probably a workshop or modeler's mark. This vase can be attributed to the Saint-Clément
