Description

Elegant and unique oval portrait, oil on canvas, in a carved and gilded wooden frame not contemporary with the painting. The painting depicts a young woman of Neapolitan aristocracy, holding a bouquet of flowers. The striking background against which the figure stands out is characterized by a carmine red drape, lending a sense of refinement to the overall image. At the center is the young woman, positioned in a three-quarter view, wearing period clothing and hair that denotes her class. Her dress features distinctive floral and geometric embroidery with lace, and a precious stone clasp is placed at the center of the dress, while pearl bracelets hang from her arms. The girl's face features a gentle gaze directed toward the viewer. Her hair is characterized by raven curls and is adorned with a

pearl clip, as is the necklace around her neck, and luxurious earrings.
