Description

Solid mahogany and mahogany veneered **COMMODE**, opening with three drawers with detached column uprights, the upper drawer with brass asparagus-inlaid fluting, the two lower drawers adorned with gilt bronze framing. Beautifully trimmed with very finely chased and mercury-gilded bronzes such as lock escutcheons, pull handles adorned with fire pots, scrolled ivy branches on detached columns, draperies at the top of the foot jambs, rings and hooves. Stamped **FEURSTEIN** for Joseph **FEURSTEIN** or **FEUERSTEIN**, Parisian cabinetmaker received Master on April 29, 1767. Joseph Feuerstein (1733-1809), cabinetmaker of Tyrolean origin, was received Maître in Paris on April 29, 1767 and established himself on rue du Faubourg
