Elegant automobile mascot depicting a winged female figure, embodying Victory. The sculpture is made of bronze with a silver patina, attached to an original radiator cap. The figure stands with wings spread skyward, topped by a star, a symbol of triumph and speed - an emblematic theme of early twentieth-century automotive aesthetics..The treatment of the body, both stylized and naturalistic, as well as the movement of the wings, testify to the influence of Art Deco, a period during which such mascots were highly prized to adorn prestige automobiles. Artist Signed by Émile Brégeon, a sculptor active in the first half of the 20th century, known for his automobile mascots and decorative sculptures. His works reflect a marked taste for movement, feminine elegance and symbols of modernity.H:
