The base features gilded bronze panels in relief with allegorical scenes of classical inspiration, underscoring the neoclassical style typical of the period. The white enamel dial, signed Le Courvoisier, is framed by a gilded bezel and houses a high-quality mechanical movement, equipped with a striking mechanism that chimes the quarters, half-hours, and hours. A piece of extraordinary elegance, harmoniously combining art and craftsmanship, ideal for collectors and connoisseurs of fine antiques.
