Description

Charmand "égoïste" service with gallant decoration, comprising a cup with saucer, a teapot, a sugar bowl and a tray with an unusual triangular-shaped and a handle, marked L.M. & Cie on the back. Founded in 1797, the Creil faiencerie was taken over in 1840 by Leboeuf & Millet, who owned the Montereau factory. The Creil & Montereau earthenware factory closed its doors in 1955, after significant production, mainly in the 19th century.
