Description

Italian stone capital, an architectural element that is both structural and decorative, serving as the upper part of a column. Historical and architectural style: This piece belongs to the Tuscan order, a Roman architectural style renowned for its simplicity and robustness. Its main characteristics are: Minimalist design: a sober, uncluttered profile, devoid of the complex carvings found in other orders such as the Corinthian. Structure: it consists of a square slab (the abacus) resting on a rounded, cushion-shaped part (the echinus). Origin: developed by the Romans as a simplified adaptation of the Greek Doric order, the Tuscan style became emblematic of Italian Renaissance architecture.
