Richly decorated with chased and gilded mercury bronzes such as column rings, palmettes and key escutcheons. Parisian Empire-period production, circa 1810. The quality and richness of the gilded bronzes (the capitals of the capitals of the columns) and the use of rare, luxurious marble, our console table is typical of the furniture found in the apartments of Princes in Imperial Palaces.
