Description

A noble coat of arms, crafted from carved, painted, and gilded wood. The central figure depicts a galloping knight, a common motif in various historical Italian coats of arms. The gilded frame and carved decorations suggest an artistic style typical of the 17th or 18th century, similar to works from Tuscany or central Italy produced during that period. **The Knight:** He is depicted with one arm raised, holding a lance. **External Decorations:** The shield is surrounded by a gilded Baroque scroll and flanked by hanging plant motifs. **Prelate's Hat:** The upper portion indicates the ecclesiastical rank of the coat of arms' holder, a common practice for prelates belonging to noble families. The artifact features a frame richly decorated with scrolls and gilded foliage, typical of the Baroque style.

Similar objects are usually used as interior decorative elements, often to evoke historical or noble contexts. Tassels are visible on the sides, often associated with ecclesiastical coats of arms (such as those of abbots or bishops), where the number of tassels indicates rank.
