French work, circa 1809-1819, bearing the Coq hallmark for Paris. Silver 950/1000. Master goldsmith: Berger Louis Jacques, a specialist in timbales and cups, active in Paris. Dimensions:- Diameter: 7.7 cm- Height: 1.8 cm- Weight: 52 g Status: Good condition; slight dents on the sides to be noted.
