Genre scene with dreaming women on the castle terrace was executed in 1849 by by morning toilet was executed by listed French romanticist genre, portrait and landscape painter Edmond Leclercq (1817 Arras - 1853 Paris)He studied under Constant Dutilleux in Arras, then came to work in Eugène Delacroix's studio in Paris. He exhibited at the Paris Salon in 1841, 1843 and 1849. A highly skilled artist, he was often sought after as a "Nègre" by painters such as Horace Vernet and Jean Charles Langlois, who asked him to paint horses or certain elements of their pictures.
