Description

Saint Sebastian Oil on canvas. Southern Germany or Austria, probably 18th century (after a Baroque model). The young saint is depicted in a half-body position, tied to a tree and pierced with arrows. His gaze, imbued with pain, turns skyward. In the upper left, a putto is shown holding a palm, the symbol of martyrdom. The composition is inspired by 18th-century Baroque models, with supple modeling and animated drapery in the spirit of rococo. Popularly inspired, slightly naive workshop work, probably intended for devotion. With its authentic painted wood frame from the late 18th century. As is.
