Description

Cross known as a "quadrille" or Saint-Lô cross, in 18kt yellow gold, late 18th - early 19th century. The openwork back decorated with foliage and fleurons is set with five cabochons adorned with imitation stones, the central stone surrounded by a crown of small brilliants in the so-called "à l'enfantement" technique. The bélière, surmounted by a Phrygian cap, bears witness to post-Revolutionary manufacture, a rare detail that anchors the piece in the early years of the French Republic. Dimensions 6.5 × 5.7 cm 13.9 g.
