### Description

From southern Italy to Provence, building a fountain or a backdrop pavilion, sometimes monumental, is a solution often chosen to give a brilliant conclusion to what should delight the senses. This large 17th-century watercolor drawing shows an impressive antique-style pavilion, featuring a large niche with a statue, two engaged Doric columns and an antique-style pediment, all inspired by Palladio, one of the greatest architects of the Renaissance. This spectacular factory is already well overgrown with vegetation. We don't know whether this is a presentation project or a survey of existing architecture, as the work is unsigned. In any case, it's a very fine document on the art of landscape gardening before the aesthetic revolution of the English garden. The drawing was glued to pink
