This tin, adorned with Native American motifs on one side and a scene from the East on the other, was made for Huntley & Palmers by Barringer, Wallis & Manners using offset lithography and embossing techniques. Although most of Huntley & Palmers' iron cans were manufactured by Huntley, Boorne & Stevens, the company also used other manufacturers, as illustrated by the East and West box.
