Indeed, they have retained their original acid-etched glass tubes and globes, beautifully worked with garlands and floral wreaths. These globes have also retained their brass rings at the top and bottom of the tube openings. They are mounted in several parts with their original reservoirs. They have received Napoleon III period bronze mounts decorated with garlands and floral motifs. The rarity of these lamps comes from their celadon green enamel color, reminiscent of the celadon color of Chinese porcelain that was very much in vogue at the time. This green is magnificent, much more
