An elegant table lamp shaped like a pinecone, crafted from ceramic and rooted in Sicilian decorative tradition. Dating from the second half of the 20th century, it features a sculptural base with typical relief work that evokes the symbol of the pinecone--a widely used iconographic element in Mediterranean ornamental art, symbolizing prosperity, hospitality, and good fortune. The body of the lamp is shaped with a dense sequence of sculptural elements that lend depth and character to the object. The surface, in a delicate neutral shade, enhances the texture of the ceramic and highlights its decorative elegance. The ensemble is completed by a truncated cone-shaped fabric shade that diffuses a warm, soft light, making the lamp suitable for classic or eclectic settings. A decorative object
