This is an early 19th century edition, published by Ferdinand Barbedienne, a famous foundry, demonstrating technical perfection and the absolute reference of the time. This is a mechanical reduction of Collas's photo of the hidden to put on the back guaranteeing a perfect fidelity or proportion of the original, created in 1850. The condition is perfect and the Brown patina work presents a beautiful depth. The mounting on the underside of the base confirms the authenticity of the period. 33 cm high, this work can be placed anywhere in your apartment.
