The reserved decoration, typical of fine glassware productions, highlights the contrast between the cobalt blue and opaline white. The balanced, refined pedestal form and decorative vocabulary evoke late 19th-century Central European production, particularly the workshops of Bohemia (now the Czech Republic), renowned for their mastery of overlay glass and enamelled decoration. This type of piece was intended for a bourgeois clientele, appreciative of elegant, colorful decorative objects. Attribution: Bohemian work (to be compared with productions by Moser
