Exceptional solid oak dining table, carved work with scroll decoration and gold highlights. Important solid oak dining table, remarkable for its generous proportions and the quality of its workmanship. This piece is distinguished by its powerful central base composed of scrolled brackets, richly carved in a spirit inspired by classical models. The scrolls are subtly enhanced with gilding, providing a refined contrast with the warmth of the oak and elegantly underlining the carving work. This decoration lends the ensemble a rare sculptural presence, halfway between furniture and work of art. The very large-diameter top can accommodate many guests while maintaining perfect visual harmony with the base. The whole presents a beautiful patina, testifying to the quality of the materials.
