### Description

Princess Mathilde. Mixed media (pencil, watercolor, gouache....) on paper "le songe d'une artiste en manque d'inspiration" signed and dated lower left Mathilde 1839. 31.3 X 23.1 cm à vue. French school. Mathilde Létizia Wilhelmine Bonaparte (1820-1904) was the daughter of King Jérôme, brother of Napoleon Bonaparte. Beyond her prestigious lineage, Mathilde Bonaparte was a talented artist, particularly in watercolor, whose technique she mastered with mastery. The weight of her ancestry unleashes a strong sensitivity in the painter, which is graphically underpinned by an imposing culture. Our drawing is a youthful work in which the artist pokes fun at her own uncertainties in the face of the immeasurable task that awaits her in her daily life as a painter. Princess Mathilde's works, rare on the market,
