Antique inlaid case in precious wood, 18th Century period . Elegant rectangular box in precious wood, richly decorated with delicate floral marquetry. The finely inlaid decoration features stylized scrolls and plant motifs in contrasting woods, testifying to high quality craftsmanship. The slightly domed lid is decorated with a delicate floral marquetry. The slightly domed lid is embellished with a finely chased ormolu keyhole, whose rocaille design underscores the Louis XV inspiration. The sides and front repeat a harmonious inlaid decoration, punctuated by floral and geometric motifs, framed by discreet fillets. The front opens onto a concealed drawer, adorned with an original ormolu handle with finely worked openwork decoration. The fittings, of fine cast quality, show

an antique patina consistent with the age of the piece. The box rests on a sober molded base, bringing stability and elegance to the whole. The warm hue of the wood, probably walnut or cherry, is sublimated by an antique patina and period varnish, revealing the natural veining and nuances of the material.
