This splendid antique display cabinet appears to be a fine piece of cabinetry in the late 17th-century Baroque style, originating from Tuscany. It features an elegant carved wooden frame, finished with faux marble lacquer and gilding. Style and Period: The decorative elements, such as the arched cornice and the figures of putti or cherubs on the sides, are typical of high-quality Baroque pieces from the late 17th to early 18th century. Made in Tuscany, with original gilding and lacquerwork; has never undergone any restoration. Materials: The frame features a refined green faux-marble lacquer (with painted veins) and gilded wood trim, a classic combination for aristocratic furnishings. Decorative Details: The top (cimasa) features two cherubs, with a small mask and
