Cliffs in Corsica, oil on wood by Benjamin Sarraillon, a French painter born in 1900 in Saint-Donat-sur-l'Herbasse (Drôme) and died in 1989 in Cassis. Signed lower right. Very good condition. Carved wooden Montparnasse frame. Dimensions without frame : 55 x 38 cm. Dimensions with frame : 73 x 56 cm. Benjamin Sarraillon was a renowned painter who began his career in Algeria in 1924. He worked in various fields such as press, advertising, and illustrating literary works. Sarraillon opened a drawing studio in Algiers and was introduced to the great Orientalist painter Étienne Dinet, who advised and supported his works. He was a member of the Society of Orientalist Painters and exhibited his works in the main salons of Algiers until 1962. After Algeria's independence, he continued to
