Description

A refined and atmospheric example of French Art Deco design, this 1920s frame combines clean geometry with the luxurious material palette that characterized the period. The rectangular, mirror-like frame, supported by two polished metal uprights, rests elegantly on a richly veined marble base whose warm tones and natural patterns provide a striking visual contrast to the coldness of the metal structure. The composition, both architectural and restrained, features clean lines, balanced proportions and a subtle interplay of textures that allow the frame to serve as both a practical display object and a sculptural decorative piece. Its silhouette reflects the modernist sensibility emerging in France between the wars, where everyday objects were sublimated by meticulous design and high-quality
