### Description

A graceful and expressive ensemble, this set of six Art Nouveau dining chairs captures the fluid elegance and organic dynamism associated with the great Belgian master Victor Horta. Crafted around 1910 and originating from Brussels, the chairs embody the movement's characteristic interplay of sinuous lines, natural motifs, and refined craftsmanship. Each chair features a delicately carved wooden frame with flowing contours that echo the architectural language of early Belgian modernism. The cane backrests introduce lightness and texture, framed by sculptural detailing that softens the geometry and enhances the chairs' rhythmic silhouette. The seats, shaped for comfort, rest on elegantly curved legs enriched with subtle ornamental carving; an homage to the artisanal spirit of the
