Silver heraldic ecclesiastical ring - chalice / monogram decoration - 19th- century Solid silver ring (tested), with wide polygonal bezel finely engraved with heraldic decoration. Description The tray features a central shield adorned with a stylized motif evoking a liturgical chalice or sacred monogram, framed by lambrequins and foliage in an ecclesiastical armorial spirit. Sober, thick setting with homogeneous antique patina, typical of a late 19th or early 20th century production. (no hallmark visible) This type of ring could have been worn as a devotional or symbolic belonging ring. Nice collector's item, halfway between religious jewelry and heraldic ring.
