Description

Painting, oil on panel "Holy Family" - 18th century A splendid oil painting on panel depicting the Holy Family, set in an elegant gilded wooden frame carved and decorated with foliage motifs, a central coat of arms, and beading. The composition features the Virgin Mary in a blue cloak and red robe, holding the Baby Jesus while holding a small crucifix--a symbolic element of the future Passion--in her hand; beside her, Saint Joseph is depicted in a contemplative pose. The iconographic arrangement and painterly style reflect the devotional tradition of Italy or Central Europe between the 17th and 18th centuries, with a soft rendering of the faces and delicate attention to naturalistic details, such as the landscape in the background. The warm color palette and subtle brushwork lend the work an intimate and

contemplative character. The small panel is likely intended for private devotion. The finely carved period frame enhances the work with a refined presence.
