Crystal perfume bottle with faceted cut, ("Soap Bubbles"), featuring a silver and vermeil setting. The body is adorned with two cartouches and floral motifs, where two cherubs reach out toward a third child on the stopper, who is blowing a soap bubble. The hinged lid is finely enamelled with arabesques in green enamel. The work--by Morel and Duponchel-- cited by Henri Vever in his book "La Bijouterie française au XIXe siècle" (French Jewelry in the 19th Century)--reproduces the design of this bottle (Vol. 1, p. 279). This splendid object is the work of the famous goldsmith Valentin Morel, circa 1840, supplier to royal and imperial families. Height: 12 cm
