Description

This walnut property console, made at the very beginning of the XIXe century in the pure spirit of the Empire period, seduces with the nobility of its wood, the controlled sobriety of its lines and the quality of its ormolu ornaments. Its rectangular top rests on an elegant front featuring an opening drawer, enriched by a finely worked dummy entrance and embellished with two large circular chased bronze handles, whose brilliance underlines the refined character of the piece. At the front, two columns, molded with flanges at the top, structure the silhouette with an architectural presence typical of the Imperial style, while at the bottom a wide shelf links the whole and offers additional display or storage space. The ensemble stands on two ball feet at the front and two straight feet at the back, providing a
