This large Imari porcelain bowl, set in a bronze mount at the end of the XIXe century, immediately imposes its presence through the brilliance of its colors and the nobility of its combination of materials. The decoration, typical of Arita production, deploys a vibrant palette of reds, deep blues and gold highlights, enlivened by floral motifs and stylized birds that testify to refined craftsmanship and remarkable pictorial mastery. The finely chiselled bronze frame envelops the bowl like a jewel box: sculpted base, scrolls of foliage and garlands of flowers, harmonious balance between curved lines and ornamental details, all combine to magnify the piece without ever betraying its spirit.
