The frame is solid and well-constructed, with fully functional brass hinges and joints. The decorative details on the corners and the bindings that simulate weaving are particularly interesting. The leather shows signs of wear and a patina of age; note that the rigid internal support of the seat is missing, having been removed over time, but it is easily restorable. The wooden frame is in good overall
