Where the classicist dared not introduce the artist's feelings into his subjects, Barye, with Romanticism, brings them to life.The figure of the serpent (evil, vice) is a recurring figure in Barye's sculptures, crushed by the Lion, symbol of triumph over evil, the latter seems wounded by the reptile. This subject is emblematic of Barye's works, each facet of this sculpture offering a new point of view & artistic message, ideal for all collectors of
