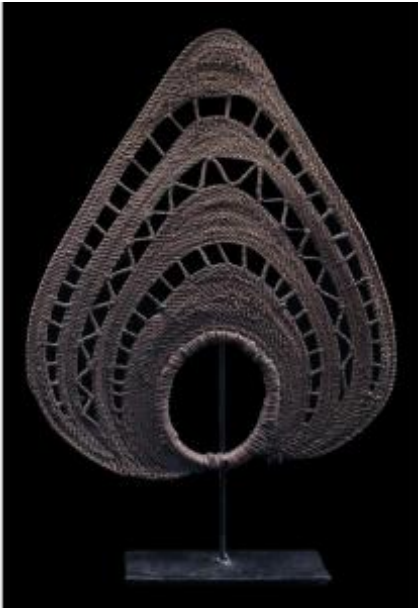

This type of headdress is used to dress up the most beautiful tubers and is usually associated with a wooden mask representing the head of the yam. Woven rush. Sold with a presentation base.
