A pair of triangular corner cabinets in carved wood, lacquered with gilded mouldings and profiles. The upper section features a shaped cabinet door with a gilded frame, decorated with floral motifs, flowering branches and leaves, on a cream ground. The lateral panels repeat the same scheme of pendant floral sprays. The cornice is moulded and gilded, centred by a carved and fully gilded rosette medallion with scrolls. The interior of each door is lacquered in yellow and fitted with three graduated shelves. The lower section consists of a triangular console with a small
