Description

This fascinating piece, attributed to resin master Pierre Giraudon, freezes a cavalcade of two galloping horses within a block of polyester resin. The work is distinguished by sophisticated accumulation work: one of the subjects is made up of brass clockwork cogs and sprockets, while the second deploys copper-toned metal shards. The aesthetics of this sculpture, blending nature (dried grasses) and industrial components, strongly recalls Arman's research on the object. The crystalline transparency of the block, combined with the play of light on the internal mechanisms, creates a poetic "snapshot" typical of the 1970s. A singular work at the crossroads of Nouveau Réalisme and collector's design. Dimensions: H 39 x W 25 x D 9cm
